



Commencement of the Class of 2018

SENIOR INFORMATION BULLETIN

As candidates for the Graduating Class of 2018, the following information is provided to assist in planning for the culmination of your high school experience. You are urged to share this information with your parents and relatives.

IMPORTANT

1. In order to participate in the commencement ceremony, **ALL** requirements for graduation (including credit requirements, attendance, financial obligations, examinations and all specific course requirements) must be fulfilled.
2. You will be barred from the commencement ceremony if you come to any of the senior events under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance.
3. **You must attend ALL rehearsals.** Work is not an excused absence from school or rehearsals. These are official days of school. **If you do not attend practice without the approval of the Principal, you will NOT participate in the commencement ceremony.**
4. The rules and regulations of the school are in effect until after the graduation exercises.
5. If for any reason you cannot attend the graduation ceremony, you are to see the Principal, Kevin Burns, at once.
6. All obligations must be taken care of prior to receiving your cap and gown.
7. Please Do Not Park in the Linwood Cornerstone Complex – they will tow vehicles.

Commencement Rehearsal Schedule

Monday, June 18, 12:30pm

Report to the Auditorium no later than 12:30pm
(After students locate and sit in their assigned seats, they will practice exiting the auditorium and walking to the football field.)

&

Awards Ceremony Rehearsal, June 18, following commencement rehearsal

Only required for students notified that they are receiving an award.

Tuesday, June 19, 12:30pm

Report to the Auditorium no later than 12:30pm.
(In the event that the weather does not permit practice outside, we will distribute caps and gowns)

****Senior social and Yearbook signing ~2:30 pm****

Wednesday, June 20, 9 am

Report to the Auditorium no later than 9 am
(Full rehearsal of the commencement exercise)

We will distribute tickets for commencement at this rehearsal. Each senior will receive 3 tickets for priority seating in the bleachers.
(Tickets are not required for guests)

You are responsible for your cap and gown. We do NOT have extras. The caps and gowns will not be collected. They are yours to keep. **The caps and gowns CANNOT be pressed with an iron.** Hanging the gown overnight should remove the wrinkles.

Report to the cafeteria immediately following the commencement ceremony to receive your diploma!



COMMENCEMENT

Wednesday, June 20, 2018

- Seniors are to report to school **at 5:30 pm** with gown, cap and tassel.
- Commencement begins at 6:30 pm.
- Each senior will receive **3 tickets** at rehearsal on Wednesday morning, which are for priority seating in the bleachers. Priority bleacher seating for ticket holders begins at 5 pm and ends at 6 pm. After 6 pm, the bleachers will be open for seating on a first-come-first-served basis. Tickets are not required for guests to attend graduation.
- Handicapped tickets and handicapped parking passes are available in the Main Office June 14th through June 20th, 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.
- Proper attire is required. No Cell Phones, No Sunglasses.
- Noisemakers (including airhorns) will not be tolerated and violators will be removed from the premises.
- Please do not bring purses, handbags, flowers, cell phones, etc. You will not be able to walk with them.
- **Report to the cafeteria immediately following the ceremony to receive your diploma.**

In the event of Rain, commencement will be held at 6:30 pm the following day, Thursday, June 21.
